1. Investigate the source of water in your home. Locate the water meter if you have one and how costs for water are calculated. Or find out the depth of your well and how it is maintained.
2. Describe and explain three ways you can decrease your water consumption. Practice them.
3. Develop a list of safe products used in your household for cleaning, sanitizing and deodorizing. Include in your list cleaners that are environmentally friendly.
4. List all uses of water and illustrate one way that water is useful.
5. Learn some ways that our country and other countries are using to improve their water supply.
6. Explore a square meter of field, ditch, marshland or rocky shore and report on the plant and animal life discovered.
7. Dramatize some evidence of pollution and its effect on our future.
8. Explore streams and rivers in your community and how they might be polluted. What can be done to improve the situation? What can you do?
9. Visit a protected resource area or arrange a clean up of some water, shoreline or creek.
10. Plan a bridging or buddy activity that incorporates one of these group projects.
