Hi Ya Pathfinders,

Welcome to the Ultimate Cookie Challenge! Want to have some fun and collect some “cookie dough”? Each activity, or challenge, listed below has a cookie dough amount assigned to it. Your cookie mission, if you choose to accept it, is to collect **\$12.00** worth of cookie dough, which is equal to three boxes of cookies.

Option 1- Cookie Commotion

a. Cookie Olympics

Cookie Dough: \$4:00

Design and plan a Cookie Olympics Day. Choose activities based on the themes: of physical fitness and the arts. Physical fitness activities may include relay races, obstacle courses, tag games, etc. Arts activities might include banners, medals, flags or costumes. *Hint: look at the activities given in the other branches cookie challenges.*

(NOTE: Add \$2.00 bonus if you plan and execute this theme day with Sparks, Brownies or Guides.)

b. Cookie Survivor

Cookie Dough: \$4:00

Play a game based on the popular television program. You can brainstorm the types of challenges such as: build a shelter out of boxes and cartons; have a sailing race using cookie boxes to make sailboats; design a daily menu using cookies and whatever other fruit and vegetation you would find on a tropical island. **Note:** you may wish to take two meetings to plan this activity. One meeting could be small groups coming up with activities and the next would be putting the activities together and playing the game.

c. Cookie Dance!

Cookie Dough: \$2:00

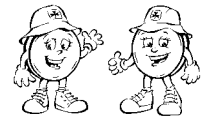
Choose a popular song and create a cookie dance that you would showcase at a cookie rally.

d. Cookie Spoon Race

Cookie Dough: \$2:00

Prepare a racetrack with empty cookie cartons with clearly defined start and finish lines. Provide each player with a Girl Guide cookie on a spoon and have someone start and time the race. The person crossing the finish line first without dropping the Girl Guide cookie off their spoon wins. If the player drops the Girl Guide cookie, they must go back to the start line and begin again.

Option 2 – Cookie Creations

a. Cookie Song

Cookie Dough: \$2:00

Create a cookie song, rap or poem that could be used in a cookie commercial.

b. Cookie Super Sellers Game!

Cookie Dough: \$4:00

Develop a cookie board game (e.g., Cookie Monopoly) for Guides or Brownies that will teach them skills like counting, matching, and following the rules. See Super Sellers game for examples of Cookie Monopoly rules and cookie money.

(NOTE: Bonus \$2.00 if you play this game with a Brownie or Guide Unit.

c. Cookie TV Ad

Cookie Dough: \$3:00

Write a 30 – 60 second television or radio commercial for either the Chocolatey Mint or Classic Sandwich Cookies. Make sure you include the benefits of selling cookies and what the cookie funds go to support.

d. Cookie Roles

Cookie Dough: \$2:00

In a group, role-play different scenarios that might occur when out selling cookies. Include customers who are cranky, obnoxious, or very inquisitive.

Option 3 – Catch the Cookie Craze

a. Cookie Newsletter

Cookie Dough: \$2:00

Create a cookie newsletter that you could send to family, friends and other units. Include some articles on fun cookie activities you and your unit have tried.

b. Cookie Banking

Cookie Dough: \$2:00

Learn about banking procedures so you can stash your cookie cash. Calculate how many boxes of cookies you need to sell to reach a goal like buying a tent or holding a party.

c. Cookie Display

Cookie Dough: \$4:00

Create a cookie display booth for mall sales. Design the display by thinking about what message you would like customers to interpret from your booth. Brainstorm ways to make the booth attractive to potential customers. What colours will you use? What types of pictures or posters will you need?

d. Cookie Day Camp

Cookie Dough: \$8:00

Plan and execute a cookie themed day camp or sleepover. Remember to include activities from each of the following categories: physical fitness, arts, quiet games, and nature. Think about the food you will serve and what kind of dress-up activities you might have.
