



Who is eligible for this bursary?

Any current paid up member of Girl Guides in the province of Manitoba, between the ages of 7 and 18, who has been an active member of Girl Guides for a minimum of 2 years and with plans of continuing membership in the province of Manitoba.

What is the purpose of this bursary?

This bursary is to financially assist active Manitoba members of Girl Guides in extra curricular education in such areas as the arts, music, dance, language, sciences and other such skill areas deemed appropriate by the committee. (Example: The cost of belonging to and playing on a hockey team is not eligible. Whereas the tuition cost of attending hockey is eligible.)

Application Deadline:

Applications for spring and summer enrolment are due on **March 15**, applications for fall and winter enrolment are due on **September 15**. Late applications will be reviewed if the budgeted scholarship money has not already been awarded.

Criteria:

- minimum of 2 years active membership
- recipient must continue paid up membership in Guiding in the province of Manitoba
- successful applicants may reapply a second time
- bursary is to assist in tuition costs only, books and equipment costs are not eligible
- only course fee/tuition costs not covered by other agencies is eligible
- members may only receive a bursary from Manitoba Council once per calendar year
- applicants must apply before reaching their 18th birthday
- course instructors must hold current accreditation or the programs offered by a recognized organization

Candidates will be evaluated in terms of the following:

- Guiding background
- letter from applicant describing what Guiding means to her and why she wishes to take this particular course
- economical well being
- two letters of recommendation (one from her Guider and one from her parent/guardian)
- course criteria and accreditation
- additional interest and activities

Bursary will be funded by Manitoba Council from:

- interest from the Scholarship/Bursary fund
- donations
- memorial donations

Funding level will be:

- 50% of registration up to a maximum of \$100.00
