As a **Ranger or Trex participant** (15-18 years of age in 2010) you will be able to participate in a fantastic and exciting program of your choice designed especially for you, while having the opportunity for personal growth and enhancement of your leadership skills.

As a **Patrol Leader/Assistant Patrol Leader** (age of majority) you will be able to work with your team and a Patrol to ensure that the **GM2010** experience is the best it can be for everyone. You will also have the opportunity to enjoy innovative programs designed just for you. This is a fantastic way to experience Guiding and all the amazing opportunities it has to offer.

Girl, Ranger/Trex and Patrol Leader/Assistant Patrol Leaders are responsible for their own transportation costs.

As **Core Crew** (age of majority, with valid Police Records Check) this is an exciting opportunity for you to volunteer your time and be an active participant in **GM2010**. Great way to challenge yourself, while contributing in all aspects of camp with an incredible team to ensure that **GM2010** is a special and unique experience for everyone. Core Crew transportation costs are covered by national.

As a Girl or Adult participant you may register as an individual or as a Patrol. If you are registering as a Patrol Guider/Assistant Patrol Guider, you will be assigned a Patrol # and be given the opportunity to list the girls you are going to have in your Patrol, you can change or update this information. Give that Patrol # to your girls and they will automatically be attached to the Patrol once they register. If you register as an individual and later connect to a Patrol the same process will work in reverse.

Non-members are welcome to apply as Core Crew, you will be required to successfully complete a Police Record Check, a telephone interview, submit 2 references. Completion of screening requirements for membership is required before acceptance and placement. Additional costs for non-members are included in the fee schedule.

GM 2010 UPDATE

PROVINCIAL SUBSIDY

Manitoba Council has approved the following subsidies for participants:

- \$500/patrol participant (girl or Guider), \$300 support to Rangers/Trex participants
- \$200 support to Core Crew participants

Please note: initial payment and registration is responsibility of the participant

Provincial support will be forwarded directly to National for each participant after the first payment has been made. The amount will exceed the second payment so the balance will be applied to the third payment. Each participant is responsible to pay the balance owing by March 31, 2010. Patrol participants (Girls and Guiders) and Rangers will also have to pay transportation costs.

Activity Selections open on July 1st and are first come first served. In order to make your activity selections the first two payments need to be submitted.

If you register before June 22, 2009 your provincial support will be applied to your account in time to make these selections (July 1st).

If you register after June 22, 2009 provincial support will be forwarded the first of each month. The last cheque will be sent to National on March 1, 2010.

(example 3 cases in the fall – mint, 3 cases in the spring – sandwich cookies = 6 cases total for the year = \$30.00)

Orders need to be made through your unit Guider and entered into the Cookie All-star program. The Provincial office will track the number of cases sold by each participant and funds raised will be put towards offsetting their travel costs to the event.
