



Frog Bog Music Maker

1. Cut rectangle from construction paper to fit around toilet paper roll.
2. Decorate paper by drawing bark, frog, twigs or bugs.
3. Glue paper to tube.
4. On one end make 2 small cuts across from each other.
5. Do the same at the other end – keep in line with first cuts.
6. Stretch rubber band from one end to other placing it in cuts.



Play instrument (pluck ends) and sing to following the tune of “Row, Row, Row Your Boat”.

“Boing, Boing?” sings a friend
In the marshy bog.
If you watch most quietly
You’ll see him on the log.

or play with song of your choice.
**Be sure to use voice dynamics to give variety to the different lines.*



Tom-Tom

Punch a hole in each side of a large can that is open at one end.

Thread & knot ribbon through the holes – long enough to hang on a child’s neck.

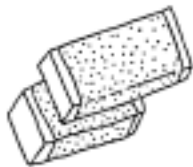
Tightly stretch a piece of rubber across the open end – securing with a heavy rubber band.

Inner tube works great – if unavailable try pieces of balloon or surgical gloves, or you can always use cloth.

New pencils with cap erasers make great drumsticks.



Cha-Chas



Coarse sandpaper glued to wooden blocks makes a great cha-cha sound when rubbed together.

CLACKERS: SAME AS CHA-CHAS WITHOUT THE SANDPAPER ATTACHED. DECORATE WITH MARKERS.
