| Day 1<br>Mon 29   | Participants will be met at Auckland International Airport and transferred to their accommodation   |
| Day 2<br>Tues 30  | Orientation drive of Auckland " <i>City of Sails</i> ". We travel up the <i>Skytower</i> , the tallest building in the Southern Hemisphere. Skytower offers amazing 360degree views of Auckland and the Hauraki Gulf. This afternoon explore Kelly Tarlton's Underwater World and Antarctic Centre  |
| Day 3<br>Wed 31   | Today travel to the beautiful Bay of Islands which is made up of 144 islands and includes a Maritime and Historic Park. It was the first centre of European Settlement in New Zealand and is rich with beaches, water activities and historical sites. This afternoon cruise the inner islands of the Bay, sail through the "Hole in the Rock", and view the dolphins that swim alongside the boat. We arrive at historic Russell this afternoon. Russell which was the first Capital of New Zealand is now a charming and elegant village with interesting shops and quaint cafes. |
| Day 4<br>Thurs 01 | Today we travel to the tip of the North island, Cape Reinga. Board the Cape runner for an exhilarating tour along 90 mile Beach, stopping at the Ancient Kauri Kingdom, the expansive sand dunes and rocky coastline. Tobogganing on the sand dunes is included with lunch.   |
| Day 5<br>Fri 02   | This morning visit the birthplace of our Nation – The Treaty House in Waitangi. We then return to Auckland today via Whangarei where we can explore the quayside and then continue to Waiwera Thermal Hot Pools before returning to Auckland this afternoon.  |
| Day 6<br>Sat 03   | Today we begin our journey south with our first stop at <i>Waitomo Caves</i> where a guide will escort you through the limestone caves and glow-worm grotto viewed by boat. This afternoon we continue our journey to <i>Rotorua</i> the "Culture Centre of New Zealand". Visit the unique village of Ohinemutu with the beautiful ethnic church. Tonight is free for you to discover Rotorua - plunge into the Polynesian Hot Mineral Waters, a great therapy, as the alkaline waters have a very soothing effect on the skin or visit a local Maori village.                      |

Day 7  
Sun 04  
This morning our first stop is the NZ Farm Show with audience participation. We then visit *Te Puia*, a unique geyser land and thermal wonderland with mud pools in a natural thermal valley. Also at Te Puia a *traditional Maori concert party* will entertain us plus we will view Maori carving and weaving as they did long ago.

**Option 1: Luge**

**This afternoon ride the gondola to Mt Ngongtaha and then ride your own luge on the exciting downhill run. Cost \$40.00**

Day 8  
Mon 05  
This morning we travel to *Lake Taupo*, which is a short distance from Rotorua. Lake Taupo has the largest lake in New Zealand and is a popular tourist destination.

**Option 2: Huka Jet:**

**Experience the awesome sensation as your Huka Jet speeds along the mighty Waikato river to the most thrilling view you will ever get of the spectacular Huka Falls. Cost NZ\$105.00.**

**Option 3: Skiing:**

**Travel to the ski fields in the Central Plateau and spend the day skiing. All equipment supplied plus ski lesson. Cost NZ\$250 (minimum numbers required)**

**A two hour horse trek through the forest (All levels) Cost NZ\$140**

**Option 5: Rocks’N Ropes:**

**This is a challenging course where you participate in teams under instructors supervision. Cost \$80.00 for half day.**
