Training Weekend for All Participants

Dates: March 5 – 7, 2010 at Circle Square Ranch Camp (between Brandon and Winnipeg)
Cost: \$20/person (province is subsidizing the remainder of cost)

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PROVINCIAL SUBSIDY

Manitoba Council has approved the following subsidies for participants:

- \$500/patrol participant (girl or Guider), \$300 support to Rangers/Trex participants
- \$200 support to Core Crew participants

Please note: initial payment and registration is responsibility of the participant

Provincial support will be forwarded directly to National for each participant after the first payment has been made.

The amount will exceed the second payment so the balance will be applied to the third payment. Each participant is responsible to pay the balance owing by March 31, 2010. Patrol participants (Girls and Guiders) and Rangers will also have to pay transportation costs.

Activity Selections are now open on the website. In order to make your activity selections the first two payments need to be submitted. If you have registered and are having difficulty making your activity selections, please contact Carla or Janet so they can assist you in resolving the issue.

Provincial support will be forwarded the first of each month. The last cheque will be sent to National on March 1, 2010.

FUNDRAISING: COOKBOOKS AND COOKIES

All proceeds from the cookbook sales will go to help offset the provincial subsidies to the participants attending GM next summer. Each participant (Girl and Adult) going to GM 2010 is asked to sell a minimum of five cookbooks. These cookbooks have been ordered by your Area council and are available from your Guider or Commissioner. The cookbooks sell for \$10.

Don't forget - there will be a prize for the TOP selling Girl Member and TOP selling Adult Member of \$25.00 for the online Guide store. Make sure you keep track of your orders!

Cookie All Stars GM Fundraising Initiative. All girl participants, including Rangers/Trex, going to GM 2010 will have the opportunity to increase their number of cases of cookies ordered for the fall and spring campaigns for the next guiding year. For anyone selling a combined total of 5 cases or more of cookies you will receive back \$5 per case of cookies sold to go towards fundraising for GM2010. (example 3 cases in the fall – mint, 3 cases in the spring – sandwich cookies = 6 cases total for the year = \$30.00)

Orders need to be made through your unit Guider and entered into the Cookie All-star program. The Provincial office will track the number of cases sold by each participant and funds raised will be put towards offsetting their travel costs to the event.

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UPDATES FROM CAMP ORGANIZERS

There are currently 1,550 people registered for GM2010! To date 1021 girls and 529 adults will be attending. Here are some other details about what's planned so far:

- The entire concept of camp is built around a Town – an old time town concept, sites are going to be built around the town concept and they will be called neighbourhoods
- Town square will have a cyber cafe that will either use tokens or tickets; girls will purchase time on the computers
- Speakers Corner concept – possibly highlighting the special events that will be happening, several other ideas floating around
- Vending to support theme days and merchandising
- Latch Hook corner
- Photo Lab – with Blacks Photography, they are going to front it to look like the very first store they opened 80 years ago (2010 is their 80th birthday)
- International trailer
- Space Station
- DJ/Radio Station
- Ice Cream day/French Fry day – possibilities
- Laundry, bank machine etc
- By the end of October the site map should be designed
- Town Square is to be a positive experience – focusing mainly on the girls, for the girls but will also incorporate the adult component of camp – but also ensures the girls have a place to go, hang out, and meet new friends - a gathering place
