

Suitable Identification for BackCheck

Acceptable primary photo identification includes:

- Provincial Driver's License
- Foreign Driver's License
- Canadian Passports
- Foreign Passports
- Canadian Citizenship Card
- Canadian Permanent Resident Card
- Certificate of Indian Status
- International Student Identity Card
- Firearms Acquisition Certificate
- Canadian National Institute of the Blind Identification Card
- Military Family Identification Card

Acceptable secondary identification includes:

NOTE: THE APPLICANT MUST BE THE SOLE PERSON LISTED ON THE SECONDARY IDENTIFICATION and THEIR NAME MUST APPEAR ON THE IDENTIFICATION

- Baptism Certificate
- Bank cards (**NAME MUST APPEAR ON THE CARD**)
- Birth Certificate
- Canadian Blood Donor Card
- Canadian Work Permit/Visa (Immigration Documents)
- Citizenship/Immigration status document
- Conditional release cards/corrections documents (e.g. client identification card from the ministry of public safety and solicitor general)
- Confirmation of Permanent Residence
- Costco Membership
- Credit cards
- Fishing License
- Health Benefits Card (**MUST BE THE SOLE PERSON LISTED, NO FAMILY CARDS ACCEPTED**)
- Hospital Card
- Hunting License
- Interim Driver's license
- Manitoba Health Cards (**MUST BE THE SOLE PERSON LISTED, NO FAMILY CARDS ACCEPTED**)
- Marriage Certificate
- Membership Card (e.g. gym card, video store card, retail store cards like Costco cards etc.)
- Professional licenses/trade certificates (e.g. Registered Nurse document, certificate of qualification/trade certificate etc.) – *Note: Certificates of completion are NOT acceptable*
- Security Screening certificate
- Record of Landing
- School ID Card

The ID MUST be physically verified by a representative of your organization on the BackCheck service order form.

The ID needs to be legible when received by fax or email. In order to qualify as legible BackCheck will need to be able to clearly see the applicant's full name, date of birth, signature and photo.
